## Apron makeover

A SECTION of tarmac in front of No 4 Squadron at RAAF Base Williamtown has received a \$1.5 million makeover.

SQNLDR John Blake from National Airfield Projects said the major repair job was par of \$2.5 million in maintenance to the base tarmacs and aprons.

"The work included demolition of the old design concrete, remediation of the 1,800 sqm site and the laying of reinforced concrete around 400ml thick," he said.

The work, undertaken by Downer EDI and Civilcraft, took three months to complete.

Inspecting the finished work last week was Base SADFO AIRCDRE Mel Hupfeld who talked of the importance of the ongoing maintenance support to infrastructure on base.

"It is a never ending job, akin to the painting of the Harbour Bridge - when you finish the job you need to start over again."
